

Big Idea – Steven Furtick  
Unstoppable Power of God

What did Pastor Furtick mean by the following opening comments?

- It's time for the Church to shine.
- We are unstoppable when we want what God wants for the reason God wants.

Have someone read Acts 3: 1-10.

1. Why did Pastor Furtick point out that the miracle took place at the gate and not in the temple? In other words, where does ministry take place?

He used Ephesians 4:11-14 to make a point. Read that passage and determine who was to do the ministry (hint – it is not the pastor).

Pastor Furtick asked us if we are making ourselves available for God to use. Discuss your answer.

What does the following statement mean: “I am a connector to the current of the Power of Christ.” Why does he want us to repeat this?

2. Pastor Furtick reacted strongly to a church member who said “I am just a volunteer!” What was he upset by this statement?
3. Vs. 5: The point was made about this verse that the beggar got more than he expected. What do we expect from our small groups? Are we asking God to exceed our expectations for what can happen in small group?
4. What did Pastor Furtick mean when he said “don't think outside the box”?
5. Have someone review the pastor's extended story about the “Power of the bunt”. What was his point to that particular aspect of baseball? Remember when Mark McGuire and Sammy Sosa were competing for the most home runs in a season? Some say is saved baseball. So why get excited about a bunt?

End with reading Ephesians 3:20. We always start with what we have but this passage teaches us to do what?
